School Responsibilities

The Buckeye Valley East Elementary staff will:

- ❖ Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the State's student academic achievement standards as follows: Buckeye Valley East Elementary supports the district initiative to provide rigorous instruction with a well-crafted, student-focused, teacher facilitated curriculum. Students will receive small, whole group and one-on-one instruction that supports their individual needs to promote a positive and effective learning environment.
- ❖ Hold parent-teacher conferences during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement. Parent-teacher conferences will be held **in the Spring and Fall** to discuss and provide feedback on your child's academic achievement and behavioral concerns. Phone conferences are available to parents who do not have adequate transportation or conflicting work hours.
- ❖ Provide parents with frequent reports on their child's progress. Specifically, the school will provide reports as follows: Interim reports will be available electronically. Report cards will be sent quarterly through electronic transmission.
- ❖ Provide parents reasonable access to staff. Specifically, staff will be available for consultation with parents as follows: Teachers are available to communicate with parents before and after school, via phone, electronic communication, or appointment.
- ❖ Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class and to observe classroom activities, as follows: Buckeye Valley East Elementary welcomes parent volunteers. Parents that would like to volunteer are required to contact Buckeye Valley Board of Education and submit to a background check. Parents who would like to observe in their child's classroom are required to contact school staff 24 hours in advance to schedule a classroom observation.
