First & Second Grade

NWEA

The NWEA Measures of Academic Progress® (MAP®) computerized tests are adaptive and offered in Reading, Language Usage, and Mathematics. When taking a MAP® test, the difficulty of each question is based on how well a student answers all the previous questions. MAP® assessments are used to measure your student's progress or growth in school. Teachers use this information to help them guide instruction in the classroom. NWEA is administered three times throughout the year.

F & P BAS

The BAS is a comprehensive assessment that is administered one on one with the goal of identifying individual reading level in order to create a match of instructional practices and texts. The assessment is administered up to three times per year.

Writing Diagnostic

This writing assessment is used to identify progress and share with the State Board of Education. It is administered one time per year in the spring.

CoGat (*Only Grade 2)

Tool used to assess students' abilities in reasoning and problem solving using verbal, quantitative, and nonverbal (spatial) symbols. This assessment is used to identify students with superior cognitive ability under the requirements of The Ohio Department of Education. It is administered in December.
