### **Kindergarten**

#### **KRA**

In the 2015-16 school year, we will again be implementing Ohio's Kindergarten Readiness Assessment. This assessment includes ways for teachers to measure a child's school readiness. [Ohio's Early Learning and Development Standards](#) (birth to kindergarten entry) are the basis for the Kindergarten Readiness assessment. It has six components: social skills (including social and emotional development, and approaches toward learning), mathematics, science, social studies, language and literacy, and physical well-being and motor development. Administration window is between the first day of school and Nov. 1.

#### **NWEA**

The NWEA Measures of Academic Progress® (MAP®) computerized tests are adaptive and offered in Reading, Language Usage, and Mathematics. When taking a MAP® test, the difficulty of each question is based on how well a student answers all the previous questions. MAP® assessments are used to measure your student's progress or growth in school. Teachers use this information to help them guide instruction in the classroom. NWEA is administered three times throughout the year.

#### **ESGI**

Assessment system used to identify level of understanding and accuracy on basic skills. Information is used to tailor classroom instruction. Administration occurs prior to reporting periods and based on individual student needs.

#### **F & P BAS**

The BAS is a comprehensive assessment that is administered one on one with the goal of identifying individual reading level in order to create a match of instructional practices and texts. The assessment is administered up to three times per year.
