NWEA

The NWEA Measures of Academic Progress® (MAP®) computerized tests are adaptive and offered in Reading, Language Usage, and Mathematics. When taking a MAP® test, the difficulty of each question is based on how well a student answers all the previous questions. MAP® assessments are used to measure your student's progress or growth in school. Teachers use this information to help them guide instruction in the classroom. NWEA is administered three times throughout the year.

AIR Assessment

State chosen assessment to inform state report cards and identify big picture district performance on standards in the areas of ELA, Math, Science & Social Studies. Current state guidance indicates one spring administration window.

F & P BAS

The BAS is a comprehensive assessment that is administered one on one with the goal of identifying individual reading level in order to create a match of instructional practices and texts. The assessment is administered up to three times per year.

Writing Diagnostic (*Only Grade 3)

This writing assessment is used to identify progress and share with the State Board of Education. It is administered one time per year in the spring.
